

## Questions you may be asked during your visa application and at Immigration

When you go to make your visa application, you may be asked a variety of questions to make sure that you are intending to come to study on the Bath International Foundation Year, and that you have enough money to pay for your studies. You may also be asked similar questions at Immigration when you arrive in the UK.

Here are some of the questions you may be asked. Make sure you understand them and can answer them!

### Questions regarding your intention to study:

- Why do you want to study in the UK?
- What are the benefits of studying in the UK, compared to your home country or USA/Canada/Australia etc?
- Why did you choose the Bath International Foundation Year?
- How did you find out about it?
- Which other colleges or universities have you considered?
- Where is the college? Where is the university?
- Do you know anyone who has already studied there?
- Do you know approximately how large the college or university is?
- Why did you choose this course of study?
- What is the relevance of the course to your future career path?
- What qualification will you receive?
- How long is the Bath International Foundation Year?
- How is your course assessed?
- Do you know what level your course is at?
- Are you planning to stay in the UK after you complete your study to get a higher award?
- Are you considering a transfer to a different institution after you complete this course?
- Do you know what facilities there are at the college and university?
- Will you need help to find accommodation?
- Do you understand the responsibilities of students entering the UK with a Tier 4 visa?

### Questions regarding financing studies:

- What is your current occupation?
- Do you have any family members who have studied at a similar level or studied overseas?
- Who is financing your studies?
- What is the profession of your financial sponsor and what relationship are they to you?
- Can you prove the money is available for study?
- Will you be able to pay your tuition fees in full before the course begins?
- Have you checked the refund policy?
- Do you know what your accommodation will cost in the UK?
- Do you know how much your living expenses will be?
- Do you know whether you are allowed to work part-time in the UK?
- Do you know how many hours you are allowed to work?
- Do you have to work to finance your studies?

Do not worry too much about this, as you can answer confidently and clearly about your status as a student on the University of Bath International Foundation Year. However, you might want to think about how you would answer these questions if you are asked.
