Course Type: Part Time Qualifications

Level: 5

Duration: 18 or 20 weeks

This course will provide you with training to enable you to teach English as a Foreign Language anywhere in the world. The CELTA is widely recognised and is a level 5 qualification on the QCF (Qualifications and Credit Framework). You do not need to have any previous teaching experience.

### Who is the course aimed at?

This course is aimed at anyone interested in teaching English for Speakers of Other Languages either in the UK or abroad.

### What are the entry requirements?

You need to be 20 years old or over, have a standard of education equivalent to that required for entry into higher education and an English level of C2 on the CFR.

If you do not have formal educational qualifications at the level indicated above or are aged between 18 and 20, we **may still accept you** if you can demonstrate that you would be likely to complete the course successfully.

You will need to successfully complete a language awareness task and an interview to be accepted on the course.
