

Counselling Skills Level 2 Certificate

This Counselling Level 2 course you will focus on the development of your counselling skills. The course aims to provide a comprehensive introduction to a range of counselling skills and an understanding of the importance of using counselling skills within published ethical frameworks, such as those from the [National Counselling Society](#) (NCS), [British Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy](#) (BACP) and the [United Kingdom Council for Psychotherapy](#) (UKCP). This course will also help to increase your self-awareness.

What topics are covered?

You will develop your understanding of how to support others with grief and loss, counselling theory and develop key counselling skills.

What are the entry requirements?

You will have good communication skills and enjoy working closely with others.

An interview is required. Applicants for this course must be aged 16 or over.

What qualifications will I gain?

You will gain a Level 2 Certificate in Counselling Skills.
