

Interior Design - Professional

Duration: 10 weeks

This Professional Interior Design course will introduce you to what it's like to be an interior designer, working on domestic and commercial projects. You will learn how to communicate your design to clients and how to manage projects with teams of tradespeople. You'll also gain an insight into the business of interior design and how some other designers manage their work, as well as being introduced to floor planning.

You must have a basic Adobe Photoshop skills and experience of using Apple Macs.

What topics are covered?

Colour – use of colour; schemes and colour preference in client and designer; Space- usage & planning; Creating cohesive rooms; Environmental psychology; Project stages & management; Measuring; Communicating designs to trades and clients; Use of Photoshop and floor planning tools.

Who is the course aimed at?

Anyone who is considering a career in Interior Design.

Sim Barker is a designer with 17 years of experience working with domestic and commercial interiors. The rooms she creates are warm and welcoming, bringing beauty into client's homes and workplaces. Using freehand drawing, the internet, Photoshop and floor-planning tools. Computer experience and specifically some use of Photoshop would be an advantage, but not essential.
