

Life Drawing

Course Type: Part Time Love2Learn

Duration: 10 Weeks

Location: City Centre Campus

This course explores the representation of the human form, working from the life model. Study is based on observation using short and long poses. Sessions provide opportunities for experimentation and the development of various drawing skills. Students of all levels of ability are welcome and are fully supported in building a portfolio.

What topics are covered?

Understanding proportion; Drawing techniques and approaches; Development of observational awareness; Developing and understanding of shape and form; Materials and their uses – charcoal, ink, graphite, pastels.

Students of all levels of ability are welcome.

Who will be my tutor?

Jackie Harding. “My lifetime passion for drawing and painting began when I was a child. I attended Junior Art School in Sheffield from the age of 11, going on to Sheffield College of Art. I finished my art education at the Slade School of Fine Art in the 1960s, where I was lucky enough to have Frank Auerbach as my personal tutor.”

Since then I have continuously taught Painting and Drawing part-time, whilst pursuing my career as an exhibiting painter.

Over these many years I still retain my enthusiasm in passing on all the knowledge I have accumulated to share with my students in this never ending journey of study.

How will I learn?

Individual guidance is given through the development of observational and practical skills; Peer reviews; Study of painters/artists past & present.
