

Site Carpentry Level 2 Diploma

Course Type: Part Time Qualifications

Level: 2

Duration: 36 weeks

Location: City Centre Campus

This course is designed for adult learners who wish to achieve their full level 2 qualification in site carpentry. The Site Carpentry Diploma allows you to learn, develop and practice the skills required for employment and/or career progression in Site Carpentry. Successful completion of the level 1 Carpentry & Joinery Diploma is usually required. It covers the following skills: first fix flooring and roofing; first fix frames, partitions and stairs; second fixing operations; carpentry maintenance; setting up and operating a circular saw.

What topics are covered?

Topics covered include

- Health, safety and welfare in the construction and associated industries.
- Understanding information, quantities and communications with others.
- Understanding construction technology.
- Preparation and use of portable power tools.
- How to carry out first fixing operations.
- How to carry out second fixing operations.
- How to carry out structural carcassing operations.
- How to carry out maintenance to non-structural carpentry work.

Who is the course aimed at?

This course is aimed at mature students who are looking for a condensed version of the Level 2 Carpentry course. It runs for one day a week at the Construction Centre, Somer Valley Campus and requires considerable commitment and a high level of motivation from applicants.

What are the entry requirements?

Completion of the [Level 1 Diploma in Carpentry and Joinery](#).

What qualifications will I gain?

You will gain a Level 2 Diploma in Site Carpentry.
