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# Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools Level 2 Certificate

Course Type: Part Time Qualifications

Level: 2

Duration: 36 weeks

Location: City Centre Campus and Somer Valley Campus

This level 2 qualification is delivered on a part time basis, with sessions held during the morning at our City Centre Campus in Bath. It is tailored for those individuals who are employed by a school or who work as a volunteer. It will provide you with the skills and knowledge required to support learning in schools. You will be expected to attend College one day a week to obtain the theory element of the programme, which will include written assignments. In addition, your practice will be observed and assessed in your workplace. You will be expected to have an IT qualification at level 1 and English and Maths at GCSE grade D (or an equivalent qualification).

## What topics are covered?

Topics include:

- Health & Safety.
- Child Development.
- Schools Organisations.
- Safeguarding and Welfare of Young People.
- Equality and Diversity.
- Supporting young people with Special Educational Needs.

## Who is the course aimed at?

This course is aimed at individuals and sector professionals working in a school, who wish to enhance their skills for the benefit of their learners, and gain a recognised qualification.

## What are the entry requirements?

You will need to be currently working in a school or looking to volunteer as a Teaching Assistant. You will also need a level 1 qualification (or equivalent) in English, Maths, and Information Technology – or be prepared to upskill to obtain these qualifications.

## What qualifications will I gain?

You will obtain a Level 2 City & Guilds qualification in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools.

## Who will be my tutor?

This will be confirmed at interview.

## How will I learn?

You will learn through attending the scheduled sessions to ensure you receive the required input. Your learning will be enhanced through group work including presentations, role play, and project work. You will be expected to complete a number of assignments at the required standard, and receive workplace observations where you will be given supportive feedback to enhance your learning further.

## How will I be assessed?

The modules are assessed via a variety of methods: presentations, essays, video analysis, online discussions, journals, portfolios, and a final research project. There are no exams for this qualification.

## What can I do after this course?

You could enrol onto our level 3 programme, which is available as a part time standalone qualification, or as part of an Advanced Apprenticeship; both pathways will allow you to progress onto the Foundation Degree which is a two-year, part time programme delivered through Bath College.

## How much does this course cost?

This Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning costs £1417.

## **Are there any additional costs?**

This has yet to be confirmed, but you will be informed at interview.

## **What do I need to bring?**

You will need to bring proof of identity, and evidence of your UK residency status (for example a passport or visa).
