### 16-18 Bursary Fund

The following students can access this fund if they meet the eligibility criteria in the table below:

- ✓ Students aged 16-18 in full time further education or a Traineeship
- ✓ Students aged 19 on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2019 and who are on the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of their Level 3 course
- ✓ Students aged 19-24 who have EHCP
